to our Nursery at New Generation Church! We are excited to care for the young children as they begin their walk with Jesus at this young age. We believe your child is a gift from God—so we want to provide the best love and care possible. We, as your nursery team, thank you for giving us the opportunity to serve your child. Our commitment is to maintain a loving, healthy, fun and safe environment for your child infant through age 3.

This brochure has been prepared to acquaint you with a few simple guidelines that will assure proper care and protection while your child is in our Nursery. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or comments about our nursery.

Curriculum

Children are taught truth about our awesome God through age appropriate Bible stories, worship songs, arts projects, coloring, along with structured play time and snack.

Check In/Out

When visiting the nursery for the first time you will be asked to complete a child information sheet.

Check In: When you check in we will ask that you sign your child into the nursery at the counter.

Check Out: For the safety and protection of your child, children will only be released to the adult or sibling at least 14 years old, presenting the security tag.

What to Bring

- · Extra change of clothes
- For bottle-fed children please provide a plastic bottle. All bottles should be prepared (premixed formula or juice), or formula and measured water provided.
- Label all of your child's belongings
- Diapers

When will a parent be paged

- If your child continues to cry after 10 minutes
- If child causes or has an injury that leaves a mark or order cannot be obtained.
- If the child becomes ill during the service.
- If the care giver is not comfortable with your instructions, you may be called to feed your child.

Health Guidelines

We want to provide a healthy environment in our nursery, so we ask you to keep your child at home when you observe any of the following.

- Fever
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Pinkeye or discharge in or around the eyes
- Common Cold with yellow/green discharge
- Excessive coughing
- Questionable rash
- Any communicable disease (including head lice)

If your child becomes ill while in the nursery, you will be notified immediately. If your child is being treated with antibiotic, he or she should have received treatment for at least 48 hours before coming to the nursery. For your child's protection, we ask our caregivers to follow the same guidelines.
